PROCEDURE FOR MOVING (company) \_\_\_\_\_ MG POSITIVE  
 BREEDERS INTO or WITHIN GEORGIA FOR PROCESSING, (date) \_\_\_\_\_

1. Treat birds with an approved drug for at least 3 days at full therapeutic dose.
2. Load birds for a minimum of 3 days after the end of the treatment period or follow proper withdrawal period.
3. Process on a Friday, in this case, on (date) \_\_\_\_\_ last load of the week.
4. Make sure the crews are asked to take a shower immediately after they get home or before they go to another farm. This is important to avoid transmission of MG to other birds that they may come in contact with. Their personal vehicles should also get sanitized if they are going to travel to other farms in the same vehicles.
5. At the Plant: Thoroughly wash first, then sanitize the truck bay area, coops, trucks and equipment after processing, as the plant's normal procedures dictate. The weekend down time will help decrease possibilities of disease transmission.
