


The New Emergency Response Diorama is COMPLETED!

Freddie Smith and Bob Wheeler have done it again! We added a new 25 square foot diorama to our mezzanine. It depicts the response activities on a breeder farm that was (mock) diagnosed with avian influenza, including foam depopulation, disposal by burial, composting, incineration and landfilling, as well as the decontamination unit and state patrol at the farm entrance, a neighbor backyard flock being depopulated with the MAK unit, and the DNR testing wild waterfowl on a nearby pond. Our visitors are first shown a map of a 3 and 10 km zones around a farm and explained surveillance and permitting for movement. Then they walk to the small diorama to discuss all response activities. This part of the tour is highly interactive and has been shown to a few visitor groups already, with great reviews!




AAAP Meeting, Washington DC : GPLN had a total of 7 posters and 3 oral presentations! Way to go, presenters!


