


## New Feature on the Portal

A helpful new feature was recently released on our portal! We think you'll find it useful when looking at your GMTs and CVs for your flocks. It is listed as Serology Report under the General Reports section.

You can filter by dates, grower, purpose, and test type. Each column title can be selected to sort in ascending or descending order depending on your need. Quickly view your titers, or export them to excel to run further analysis. Curious about how close your titers are after vaccination on a flock? Easy! Select that grower, and look at your most recent submissions. Interested in the overall trends for your flocks after a change was made to your program? Another easy one! Select your date range and run with it.
