The 2019-2020 Annual GA TITERS are published!

This year, we took a deeper dive, consulted with colleagues, and made a few changes.

- When possible, we have increased the minimum number of tested birds per flock included in the report to 12. It is epidemiologically a better number for data validity. This applied mostly to breeders. We kept broilers at a minimum of 10 (because a very large part of the data was for flocks of 10 or 11 tested).
- We changed the functional age ranges to match the flock age of the samples received at the lab, and the timing of sampling after vaccination.
- We are using tabular formats for AE and CAV, for an easier analysis of the % positive birds at each age interval.
- We have included only breeder flocks vaccinated twice with inactivated vaccines for the compilation.
- We added separate graphs for breeders flocks vaccinated with live vs killed Bronchitis vaccines (we only presented the different graphs for Newcastle disease last year).

And we found a few interesting trends.

- The AE titers are low overall and lower than last year in breeders.
- The CAV % positive data shows that our breeders continue to show high positivity rates.
- The IBD and REO titer responses in breeders are very good.
- The breeder (that do not receive a killed vaccine), broiler and layer IBV serology trends suggest constant IBV field challenges. That is consistent with previous years.
- Georgia broilers do not show evidence of Newcastle challenge. That is consistent with previous years.
