Here are some interesting trends we have found since 2016:

	2016	2019	2021
Use of Recombinant Marek's vaccines	60%	95%	83%
Use of Recombinant IBD vaccines	45%	63%	83%
Most popular IBV vaccine strain combination	ARK + GA-98 + GA-08 (25%)	MASS-ARK (16%)	MASS - GA-08 (44%)
Use of GA-08 IBV vaccine strain	40%	47%	72%
Use of ARK IBV vaccine strain	70%	47%	33%
Use of GA-98 or DE-072 vaccine strain	60%	31%	17%
Use of Newcastle disease Recombinant vaccines	20%	21%	28%
