## Sanitation Station Debut

GPLN is very pleased to announce that the receiving Department has added a new disinfecting station at the exit loop of the sample drop-off window. We encourage our customers to use this disinfection station at their discretion when they leave our facility.

The tires and wheel wells should be sprayed just enough to cover surfaces. *Soaking is not necessary or advisable.*

The disinfection nozzle and hose are located on the upper right corner of the canopy. Drive up under the canopy and follow the steps below.
